Alternate Delegate Report: Anna S

Anna S tabled the following report highlighting:

In 2017 Area E committee focused mainly on fulfilling requests from 2016 General Service Conference and General Service Office.

Firstly, Conference asked all AA members to reflect whether our current AA service structure best addresses specific needs of Australian AA Fellowship. The concerns and potential solutions were presented by the Conference as Topic 001/17, and subsequently distributed as handout to Groups in Area E. The distribution was facilitated by members of the Committee, GSRs and AA members who agreed to participate. The geographical division of our large area into smaller districts made the process easier.

In August Area E held an assembly, where the voice from groups was heard, and discussed, with great assistance from Eastern Regional Trustee, Paul B, the outcome from the Assembly indicated that groups in Area E were willing to look at the service structure and work towards an option which best ensures that AA in Australia continues to grow and thrive. This message has been taken by Area E Delegate John B to 2017 Conference, and he will expand on what took place there in his report.

Secondly, GSO appealed to all AA members to answer to survey that would help to update facts about recovery in our Fellowship. The main aim was to gather current information for discussion with professional community for better general support of recovery from alcoholism in AA. Again, the personal approach of handing out the survey at AA meetings, reaching those who are not inclined to use their email for AA related correspondence or simply do not use computers. Delegation of responsibility according to districts afforded good results, a few members gathered the data and entered it on line.

Overall, this year has been rewarding in observing how our area practised the first four Concepts for service: we took responsibility for completed tasks at the group and area level (Concept 1), we found efficient and effective ways to accomplish them (Concepts 2 and 3) and we participated (Concept 4).

Linda, PI Officer from Dee Why Thursday night also reported how they have been providing AA pamphlets to Brookvale Centrelink. The Message to Teenagers has been the most popular with an estimated 200 taken.
